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## Admissions Procedures 2012-2013

Thank you for your interest in Providence Classical Christian School! The selection and composition of the school's student body is second only to staff and faculty selection in the impact it has upon our school's mission. Providence Classical Christian School seeks to foster an atmosphere of shared values centered in biblical truth, and our desire is that each family become an integral part of the vibrant Christian school community.

Please complete the application and mail or fax it to the above address, or drop it by the school. All applications (other than from current families) will be considered on a first-come, first-served basis. **We strongly encourage prospective parents to attend an Open House and visit classrooms.** The process for new applicants is as follows:

### Application Procedures

Keep this list handy and check off each item as it has been submitted. This will help expedite your application and prevent any delays in the admissions process.

#### A. Please submit the following (together if possible):

- \$100 Application Fee (each new student, non-refundable)
- Completed application packet
  - New Family Application (one per family)
  - New Student Profile (one for each student applying)
  - Signed Statement of Faith
  - Student Questionnaire (7<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup> only)
- A copy of the last Standardized Achievement Test (if applicable)
- A copy of the last two report cards or grade reports (if applicable)
  - \* If home schooled, a list of all courses and books from the last year of child's education

#### B. School Visit

Prior to the interviews and assessment test, we strongly encourage families to visit the school and classrooms. Students are encouraged and invited to visit and spend a day in the classroom. Visits can be arranged by contacting Mary Jean Butaud, Admissions Director, at 425-774-6622.

#### C. Interview and Assessment Test

The application, application fee, and other materials above MUST be submitted prior to the family interview. Schedule a day for the family interview (student and both parents) and taking the grade-level assessment test.

#### D. Notification

The admissions committee will meet and notify parents generally within two weeks of the family interview. If a student is accepted for admission to Providence, parents will be given an enrollment packet to submit with the enrollment fee in order to reserve a place for their child.

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## Statement of Faith

The following is the foundation of beliefs on which Providence Classical Christian School is based. They are also the key elements of Christianity that will be unapologetically taught in various ways through all grade levels. The substance of these statements is that which will be considered *primary doctrine* in the school. Secondary or divisive doctrines and issues will not be presented as *primary doctrine*. When these types of doctrine or issues arise they will be referred to the family and local churches for final authority.

### Summary Statement

We believe the Bible to be the inerrant and only Word of God, plenary inspired by the Holy Spirit. It is our only authoritative rule for faith and practice. It is the supreme standard by which all human conduct, creed, and opinion shall be tried and is the standard of and for all truth.

We believe that there is one God, eternally existent in three persons - Father, Son and Holy Spirit. He is omnipotent, that is, He is all-powerful. He is omnipresent. That is, He is present throughout Creation but not limited by it. He is omniscient. That is, nothing is hidden from His sight. In all things He is limited by nothing other than His own nature and character. We believe the God we serve is holy, righteous, good, severe, loving, and full of mercy. He is the Creator, Sustainer, and Governor of everything that has, is, or will be made.

We believe in the true deity and full humanity of our Lord Jesus Christ, in His virgin birth, in His sinless life, in His miracles, in His vicarious and atoning death through His shed blood, in His bodily resurrection, in His ascension to the right hand of the Father and in His personal return in power and glory.

We believe in the full deity of the Holy Spirit, acknowledging Him together with the Father and the Son as Creator and Redeemer.

We believe that because of Adam's sin all mankind is in rebellion against God. For the salvation of such lost and sinful men, regeneration by the Holy Spirit is absolutely necessary.

We believe that salvation is by grace through faith alone, and that faith without works is dead.

We believe in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit, by whose indwelling the Christian is enabled to live a godly life.

We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and lost - those who are saved to the resurrection of life, and those who are lost to the resurrection of damnation.

We believe in the spiritual unity of all believers in our Lord Jesus Christ.
